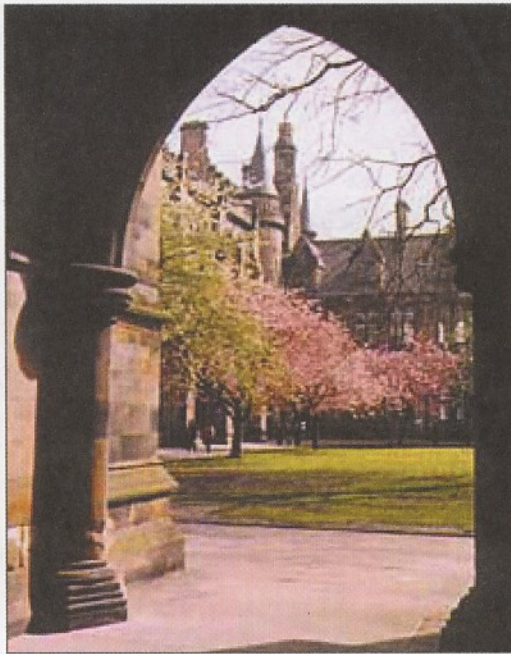

English language entry requirements: minimum IELTS 6.0 – 6.5 Some programmes require a higher level of communication skills and offers are made on IELTS 6.5 or 7.0.

£6,000 - £8,000

\\ COURSE START DATES:

All undergraduate courses start in September.

All postgraduate courses start in September and some courses also start in January/February.
